Position Summary

This position will involve general outdoor grounds maintenance tasks for Dow Gardens. Grounds work may include mowing, weeding, planting, pruning, pulling of brush, assisting with events, closing/locking the grounds, as well as other landscape tasks, under the direction of a supervisor. Responsible for completing assigned work properly and efficiently. Comply with weekly employee work schedules and applicable safety training. Other duties as assigned.

Second Shift and Weekend work will consist of weekend hours and second-shift responsibilities, which adjust and flex with seasonal time changes. From November 2 through April 14, scheduled hours will shift to an 8:00am – 4:30pm timeframe.

Minimum Qualifications

High School diploma or GED. Valid driver’s license required. Qualified candidate must be able to operate hand tools and power landscaping equipment. The ability to perform manual labor under varying weather conditions, in an outdoor environment, is required along with the ability to lift up to 35lbs. The successful candidate will commit to a minimum of 14 weeks of work. The ideal candidate will have an interest in outdoor work, enjoy interacting with the public, and appreciate physical and detail-oriented tasks.
