Position Summary

Dow Gardens is currently looking for individuals to work as Butterfly Conservatory Seasonal Attendant(s). This position will work 20-25 hours per week during the 7-week event, running from February 28 until April 16, 2023. Weekday and weekend shifts will be required. Training will be provided.

Responsibilities

This position serves as an ambassador for Dow Gardens, greeting visitors as they enter and exit the conservatory. Must be able to verbally communicate the stated rules of the containment facility and implement them tactfully in a crowded environment. Responsible for making sure that containment procedures are being followed; this may involve the use of a net to catch any escaping butterflies in the vestibule as well as confiscating any plant material being taken into or out of the conservatory. The successful candidate will be able to excel in a fast-paced, crowded environment. The candidate will also have limited exposure to other aspects of butterfly care, management and pinning.
